SUGGESTED FRAMEWORK FOR REQUESTS

Introduce yourself

• Share your name, degree program, estimated graduation date, and a little bit about yourself

Share why you think this alumni volunteer would be a good fit for you

- This is an opportunity to mention what about their profile interests you (i.e. employer, professional associations, specialty, etc.)
- Let the alumni volunteer know what connection you have to their background or profile to highlight why they would be an ideal match

Share what you are hoping to accomplish/talk about during the chat

- Be specific about what you would like to get advice, coaching, or guidance on in this call
- You can review the Chamberlain Chats Guide to articulate what you are looking for from the chat

Provide details about the chat itself

- Give a timeline on when you would like to meet and how long you anticipate the chat to last
- Be sure to ask for their availability and give multiple options for meeting times

Conclude with a thank you

Current Connections



After sending a message to the alumni volunteer, their profile will be listed under your "current connections". You can visit your connections on your home log-in screen or through the left hand navigation. You can review their profile, send follow-up messages, or release the connection once the chat has concluded.

Once the alumni volunteer has responded to your message, you will receive an email notification. You can review your conversation history and send a follow-up message by visiting the message tab or clicking on their name.
